



DEERFIELD REGIONAL STORM WATER DISTRICT 2018 ANNUAL STREET SWEEPING

The Deerfield Regional Storm Water District is seeking quotes to do our annual street sweeping for 2018.

- This will consist of three (3) sweeps, one in late March, one in late July and one in October-November timeframe (after the majority of the leaves have fallen).
- Attached is the map for the sweeping. The miles listed are Centerline Miles, not actual curb miles.
- The sweeping contractor is required to sweep each street on the map in its entirety (both sides and islands). Some of the streets have islands and or medians which require that curb line to be swept as well.
- The section on Mason-Montgomery near Fields Ertel will include both sides of the street. The section of Fields Ertel will only include the North side.
- All material will need to be dumped in our roll off dumpsters located at 3378 Townsley Drive, Loveland OH. We provide the dumpsters.
- We do not provide water, the sweeping contractor is responsible for locating a water source to fill.
- Sweeping contractor responsible for posting street "no parking" 24 hours in advance
- Sweeping contractor will need to provide certificates of liability insurance and BWC certificate.
