Summary of Results: Maintained the DRSWD website which includes the annual report, current storm water management plan and public record policy. The storm water hotline received 209 calls; Calls are returned within three days of receiving messages. There were 36 requests for assistance calls that resulted in 29 projects (17 completed/12 still in engineering/construction phase).

Comments: In 2019, the Township IT staff migrated the DRSWD website over to the Township's website. This is to allow more consistency, more timely updating of information, and ease of access for Township residents. As part of the transition, some of the information that was previously available was taken down but resources will be added back as the site is improved.

Summary of Results: WCSWCD presented material to Deerfield Township school age children reaching 3,365 students and 648 adults. In 2022, Warren Co SWCD had 27,000 Youtube views, sent out newsletters to 10,382 people, had 131, 246 facebook hits and 8,199 twitter views. Also, the development Warren Co SWCD Digest blog for developers was viewed by 2,018 people. The Regional Storm Water Collaborative, which Deerfield Regional Storm Water District is a member of, promoted a See Somthing, Say Something campaign with 4 PSA's. The campaign reached over 114,112 people through YouTube. The regional Facebook page has approximately 3,491 page views from 21,827 seperate sessions with 16,286 users. The Regional Storm Water Collaborative also hosted a green infrastructure for planners and a storm water field day reaching 123 citizens. Deerfield Township also co-sponsors the Ohio Stormwater Conference.

Comments: Media outreach is available to 100% of the population. Some events are considered Warren County-wide events or region-wide events. A percentage of this number is expected to be Deerfield Township residents.
