


Proposed Project Overview







Kingswood: North

Ohio River Foundation (ORF) Invasive Species Removal

- ORF obtained a Duke Energy Grant to cover the cost of their services for the invasive species removal; Deerfield will incur costs for providing pesticides and equipment
- 20.6 Project Area Acres Identified
- Main Species for Removal (Honeysuckle & Flowering Pear)
- Requires on-going maintenance after removal to keep invasive plants under control
- 18.64 acres are outside of project scope, but also require invasive plant species removal




Legend
